

myMCPS Parent Portal

(replaces  Edline)

For secondary schools, myMCPS Classroom is the replacement for Edline. Students and parents will be able to view announcements, assignments, events, and resources created by teachers. They will continue to be able to view grades, attendance data, and other information. In addition, parents/guardians who register during the summer will have access to update their child's emergency card online.

Additionally, parents will be able to view their child's work for assignments that were created and completed within myMCPS Classroom. They will have read-only access to courses and will only be able to view work for their child.

Parent/Guardian Information

How will parents/guardians be notified of the new portal?

Prior to the start of school, parents/guardians will receive directions via mail to create an account and associate their account to their student(s). A letter will be mailed to the primary address of the student on August 21st. The letter will provide directions and other information necessary to access the parent portal.

Does myMCPS Classroom support multiple languages? Will resources be translated into multiple languages?

Yes, myMCPS Classroom provides supports for multiple languages other than English. When accessing and using myMCPS Classroom, the default language is English, however, you can change your language preferences within the platform.

myMCPS Classroom will be available in both English and Spanish this summer. Other supported languages will be made available next school year.

How will parents/guardians and teachers communicate with one another?

Through myMCPS Classroom, teachers will be able to communicate with one or more classes at a time. Parents/guardians can respond to messages; staff can access messages via the myMCPS Classroom inbox and their default email address.

Overview and Key Features

The myMCPS Portal is a central location for students and their parents, guardians, or other authorized adults to access MCPS student information. Beginning August 2017, MCPS will send a letter with instructions and access codes for activating a portal account to the home address on file for each student. Additional instructions for accessing online forms in the portal and for accessing the mobile application will be sent after an account is created.

The myMCPS Portal will be available in multiple languages, beginning with Spanish. *¡Hablamos su idioma! Para los padres que son hispanohablantes, MCPS implementará nuestro portal en español.*

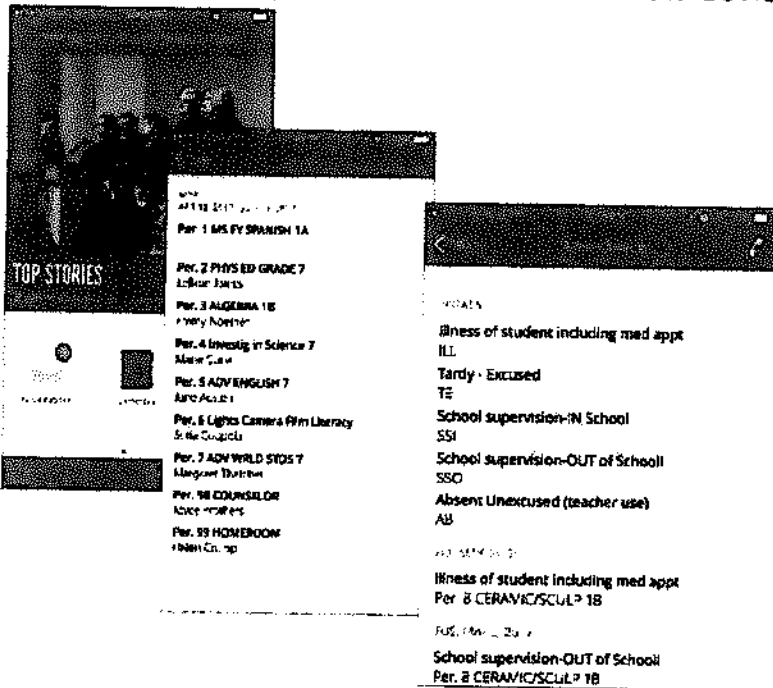
Athletic Participation Information
