

Dear Clarksburg High School Parents and Guardians,

I hope this message finds you all safe, well and enjoying the summer. I know you are anxiously awaiting more information on what the upcoming school year will look like for our school community. Please know that as details are discussed and finalized, we will be sending information to you on a range of topics including school-specific schedules, distribution of technology and learning materials, meal services, resources and supports, and much more.

On Thursday, Aug. 6, the Montgomery County Board of Education discussed Montgomery County Public Schools' (MCPS) draft Recovery of Education Plan for the 2020-2021 school year. (<u>Click here for a GRAPHIC SUMMARY.</u>) The draft guide provides an overview of the district's plan for virtual instruction for the first semester. The Board voted to approve a virtual-only reopening for the 2020-2021 school year, which begins on Monday, Aug. 31. The Board did not vote on approval of the draft Recovery of Education plan. They will review and take a final vote on the components of the virtual-only plan on Aug. 25.
