

### What did we learn?



Use Bullets to Summarize Student Feedback

- 79.5% of students have at least one trusted adult at Kennedy High School
- Students showed concern about the safety and security in the building, school spirit, and academics
- 62.9% of students feel like they belong guite a bit or somewhat at Kennedy High School



Use Bullets to Summarize Staff Feedback

- · 40.3% of staff feel our current advanced classes and enrichment opportunities are in meeting students' learning needs
- · 39.5% of staff feel that sometimes that parents and students are included in planning processes at our school
- 71.4% of staff feel that support services are communicated to students and families somewhat effectively or effectively

Use Bullets to Summarize Family Feedback

- 65.4% of families are very satisfied with teacher communication
- 67.9% of families have accessed school resources
  - Parents' primary concerns for their student are academic performance, safety, and social wellbeing
