## Applying to PEAC

- $8^{\text {th }}$ Grade students will fill out Academy Interest Survey during registration for their $9^{\text {th }}$ grade courses - select PEAC
- Students must register for Honors English 9 and Honors Biology


## 9 $^{\text {th }}$ Grade

- During the $1^{\text {st }}$ semester, students must accept all academic challenges by maintaining a 3.5 GPA.
- Students will formally apply to the PEAC Academy during the beginning of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ semester.
- Students will need teacher recommendation from 4 core academic teachers
- Students will complete a "live essay" showcasing their skills.
