Any Vietnamese American graduating from high school and residing in Maryland, who is enrolled

the MVMA College Scholarship Program. The Scholarship recipients will be required to participate
in at least one MVMA community activity or outreach event in the upcoming academic year.

Submission Requirements & Deadline

An original, signed application along with the COMPLETED checklist for the required supporting documentation (i.e., official transcript, personal essay, and letters of recommendation) must be received by the due date.
