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## Child Development 1A/B w/Lab

**For grades 9 to 12:**

.5 credit per semester; 5 SSL hours per semester **4847/4848**

For the student who is interested in working directly with pre-school children to:

- ♦ Improve child care skills
- ♦ Learn how children grow and develop

## Child Development 2A/B

**Advanced Level w/Lab**

5 credit per semester; 5 SSL hours per semester

**Course number 4880/4881**

- ♦ This course will challenge students to use higher order thinking skills as they do independent research.
- ♦ Students are given opportunities to demonstrate leadership skills in the preschool Lab setting.
- ♦ Upon completion of all certification requirements, students will be eligible to apply for the 90 +9 Clock Hours Certification. This program is recognized by the Maryland State Department of Education

## Child Development 3A/B

**Advanced Level w/Lab5**

.5 credit per semester; 5 SSL hours per semester

**Course number 4882/4883**

- ♦ This course is the third of four required courses in the Child and Adolescent Development program.
- ♦ Students enhance their skills of higher-level teaching and classroom management strategies.
- ♦ Students will explore postsecondary education and careers in the field of education
