Math: AP Statistics

World Language: AP Spanish Language, AP Spanish Literature, AP French or any fourth year of consecutive language study i.e. Spanish 4 or 5 when taken as a senior.

*To count as a magnet elective, these courses must be completed with a magnet elective project, an independent study that encourages students to engage more deeply with a topic covered in the regular course curriculum. Further study will include the following:

- college-level research in a topic within the course,
- development of an Inquiry Proposal stating the research question, method and goals of the independent work, accompanied by an annotated bibliography of sources.
- conferences with the Head of House to check progress,
- a final project which communicates the findings of the student's in-depth study in a creative format.
