During election years there are numerous opportunities for students to become involved in the political process and simultaneously earn service-learning hours.

The SSL guidelines state that any student interested in earning SSL hours for participation in campaigns of **any** candidate running for public office <u>must first</u> <u>submit MCPS Form 560-50</u>, <u>Individual Student Service Learning Request</u> and have it granted by the school SSL coordinator (Mrs. Soni in room 204) **in advance** of any student service.

Then, with an approved *MCPS Form 560-50 SSL*, hours may be earned in a variety of activities that **occur in public places under direct supervision of adults' campaign officials** (**not related to student**). These public activities may include rallies and polling places.

SSL hours **may not** be earned for any neighborhood canvassing involving doorto-door activity, telephoning requesting financial donations, or any service performed in other than a public place.

All hours must be documented using MCPS Form 560-51, *Student Service* Learning Activity Verification, and submitted on or before the deadlines printed on the form.

Students interested in providing "Polling Place Coverage" with The Montgomery County Democratic Central Committee may do so with no MCPS Form 560-50 required in advance. The organization and this one opportunity are identified as MCPS SSL approved on the database.
