The Ceramics and Sculpture program begins with exposing students to hand-building and beginning sculpting methods and leads into a rigorous investigation of ceramics and sculpture as a method of self-expression and fine art.

This seminar is geared to exposing students to throwing on the wheel as well as pre-AP investigation. Students will concentrate on the techniques and methods of throwing on the wheel from centering, lifting, to trimming.

In addition, students that wish to pursue ceramics and sculpture further will get a chance to begin working on a concentration and breadth of work based on the structure of the AP 3-D Studio Art exam. Students are introduced to various traditional methods, techniques, and materials while encouraged to incorporate their own artistic voice.
