IB Career-related Program requirements at WMHS

The IB Career-related (CP) Program at WMHS involves three tiers of responsibility:

- I. Responsibility to complete all four components of the IB CORE.
 - A. Three Semester Course: Personal and Professional Skills (PPS) [formerly Approaches to Learning] Full year in 11th, First Semester in 12th. This course develops transferable skills needed to operate successfully in a global society. The focus of the course includes:
 - Thinking Processes: Ethical thinking, Universal values
 - Intercultural understanding: Your cultural profile, characteristics of your culture, cultural differences
 - Effective Communication: Group dynamics, conflict resolution, empathy, leading others
 - Personal Development: self-awareness, social awareness, self -management, relationship management
 - Applied ethics: Repercussions of riots, youth responsibility in social context.
 - **B.** Within the PPS course students will be guided through the process of developing research skills, and this process culminates in the formal **Reflective Project** to be submitted in its final form in fall of 12th grade. The Reflective Project (RP)-emphasizes an ethical dilemma associated with a particular issue drawn from the student's career-related studies through the completion of an extended piece of reflective writing or presentation in some other format.
 - **C.** Language Development requirement. Complete Language Development (LD) Portfolio through one of the choices below:
 - 1. IBDP Language Acquisition course during the junior and senior year as a third, fourth or fifth IBCP course, with Language Portfolio
 - 2. Any WMHS Language Course during the junior or senior year, with Language Portfolio
 - 3. Self-Study Option in partnership, with Language Portfolio (see IBCP Coordinator for more information)
 - **D.** Complete a **Service Learning** (SL) Experience(s): CS experience is supported within the PPS course and must be completed by May 1st of Senior Year. Students are expected to spend a minimum of 50 hours outside of class on their CS experience(s) and submit reflections on the experience(s) to the IBCP coordinator.

- II. Complete two or more **Diploma Courses**, one which spans BOTH 11th and 12th grade.
- III. Complete all courses, internships, and assessments required for certification in the student's chosen career academy.
