

Parent Access: How to Access the Culture of Respect Demo Course

Students will be pre-enrolled into a Culture of Respect Student Training course in myMCPS Classroom. To preview the demo course, you will need to have an activated ParentVUE account. If you do not have an activated ParentVUE account please contact your child's schools for a copy of your activation letter.


If you have a ParentVUE account, follow these steps to access the Culture of Respect Demo Course:

Step 1:

Log into ParentVUE at https://md-mcps-psv.edupoint.com/PXP2_Login.aspx

Step 2:

Go to the Parent Resources tab and click the link for myMCPS Classroom



Step 3:

Once you are logged into myMCPS Classroom, copy and paste the follow link in the the web browser: <https://mcpsmd.instructure.com/enroll/JDC6DW>


Step 4:

Click the button to enroll in the course and then use the link to go to the course



How do students begin the course?

The home page of the course has links to the three components of the course. Students must complete each of the items listed in the module at the bottom of the home page in the order that they are listed.



How do students complete the training portion of the module?

To begin the training, students will click the button to load the tool in a new window.



- The training presentation will open in a new window and students must click the “play” button on the screen to begin.




- Students will navigate through the presentation using the player controls:
 1. **Menu** - Click on the menu icon in the upper left to view the slides in the presentation and current progress. Slides viewed will be marked with a checkmark, while slides not completed will be marked with a lock icon.
 2. **Play** - Use this to play/pause the timeline.
 3. **Timeline** - A colored bar will indicate the time elapsed on the timeline. Most questions and other interactions will not be available to the user until the timeline bar is complete.
 4. **Replay** - To listen to the content on a slide again, use this button to restart the slide.
 5. **Sound** - Use this icon to increase/decrease player volume. Please be aware that you may also need to adjust the volume using the sound controls on your device.
 6. **Closed Captioning** - Click this icon to turn on/off captioning of the audio.
 7. **Accessibility Controls** - This icon will give you access to turn on/off additional accessibility features such as Zoom to fit, accessible text, and keyboard shortcuts.
 8. **Prev/Next** - Use these buttons to control movement to the next and previous slides in the presentation. For the first time viewing a slide, the "Next" button will be disabled until the timeline has finished. Once the timeline has ended or you have completed the task required on the slide, you will need to click "Next" in the player to continue the presentation.




- Some slides will automatically advance, while others may require the student to watch a video first or think about the content before clicking the "Next" button. Other slides may require students to select a response to a question on the slide in order to advance.
- Students must progress through all slides until they reach the final slide where they will be prompted to return to the module to complete the post-assessment.

- The module will automatically be marked as completed for students when they reach the conclusion slide.

How do I complete the post-assessments?



Once the student has started the assessment, they should:


1. Answer the question on the screen by selecting the best choice.
