What is Edline?

Edline is website where class information, assignments, and grade reports can be found.

How can I get my activation code?

Parents and students received their activation code in the summer. If you are new or do not have your code, you can email/call the counselor or the edline super user (Ms. Guzman) identify if you need a parent or student account, your full name, child's first and last name, and id number.
