- A 560-50 is required in advance of any involvement
- NA is written in the Tax exempt area
- All activities for which hours are awarded must be performed in a public place under the supervision of an adult representing the campaign..not a parent or relative.
- No hours are awarded for any door-to-door canvassing or neighborhood door-knocking
- No hours are awarded for any telephone solicitation for donations.
