Hello parents/guardians,

We are very excited that your student is interested in the tech crew for our spring show, Willy Wonka. Tech crew consists of two components, building crew and running crew. Running Crew students will be moving sets on stage, operating lights or spotlights and sound (during the show).

Both Building Crew and Running Crew will meet on Tuesday, February 21st from 3-4:15 pm. Building Crew will meet on <u>Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 3-6 pm</u> starting on (Tuesday, February 21st from 3-4:15 pm) through Thursday, March 30th. Running Crew will meet on <u>Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 3-6 pm</u> starting on <u>Tuesday,</u> <u>April 11 from 3-6 pm through May 19th</u>. Running Crew is required to attend all technical rehearsals which are held on <u>May 8, 9, 10, 11, 15, 16, and 17 from 3-6pm</u>. They are also required for the shows on <u>Thursday, May 18 and Friday, May 19 from 7-9:30pm</u>. Students report by 5 pm to the gym on both show nights.

As part of the application for tech crew, the students will need to have two of their teachers recommend them. They need to show that they are responsible when handling set pieces, costume pieces, props, lighting, and sound. The students will also need to fill out the last page of this packet explaining why they want to be a part of the tech crew. Students will receive SSL hours for assisting with tech crew. *Students may be asked to complete an interview with Ms Pfeufer & Ms Goldiner/Stutsky during A/B/C lunch to determine the student's level of commitment (the week of February 13th).*
