Enduring Understanding

Having the ability to easily create and obtain information via the Internet has changed the way people think.

Goals

Students will:

- Trace the development of the Internet and World Wide Web and how its affected our society
- Explore issues such as copyright and validity of information on the web
- Identify and apply the elements of good web page design
- Experiment with HTML code and web editing programs

Objectives

Students will:

- Study the history of the Internet and World Wide Web
- Describe the impact of the Internet on society
- Review websites for their ease of use and content
- Identify the audience and purpose of websites
- Plan a web site
- Use HTML to design a web page that is rich in content and design friendly
- Use a web editing program to create a website that is rich in content and design friendly

Content and Final Grading Scale

Daily & Weekly Activities10%

Students will participate in daily and weekly activities to enforce, extend, and enrich the classroom curriculum.

Class Work15%

Students will participate in activities that practice and apply skills learned throughout the course. These skills may include researching the history of the internet, evaluating websites for content, design, navigation, accessibility and maintainability, HTML coding, and the manipulation of graphics to enhance their projects.

Final Project40%

Students will be asked to create a web site that centers on an academic theme. This project will encompass all skills learned during this 12 week rotational class.

Assessments25%

Students will be assessed on skills learned throughout the semester. These assessments will be in the form of tests, quizzes, and standard based assessments.

Homework10%

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Class Expectations

Students are expected to:

- Attend class regularly
