

#### What is Outdoor Education (OE)?

- 3 day 2 night environmental program
  - Part of MCPS 6<sup>th</sup> grade curriculum
- Incorporates classroom learning into real life situations & experiences
- Develops interpersonal skills, teamwork & cooperation
- Expected that all students attend
  - RH has one of the best attendance rates in the county!
- A FABULOUS experience
  - We are shaped by our experiences then how do we know if we don't like it if we don't try it!



#### **General Information**

\$85 fee - payable via check, cash or online (RH website)

- Scholarships are available
- Includes transportation, meals, insurance, lodging, supplies (s'mores, prizes, pictures, life savers, glow in dark necklaces, critter show, etc)
- Camp Letts (Edgewater, MD)
- 2 sessions
  - Session 1 March 2 4
  - Session 2 March 4 6

#### Well supervised

- 15-20 staff members, 10+ parents, & 20 high school student counselors
- · Sleep in cabins
  - 10-12 students/cabin
  - 6 bunk beds
  - Supervised at all times by high school counselor, parent, or teacher
  - 2 showers, 2 sinks, 2 toilets
- In case of emergency call RHMS even after hours & we will check messages.

- Separate by color
  - · General info yellow
  - · Parent Volunteer green
  - · Forms to return white
  - 55555
- Permission slip, money & are due February 14<sup>th</sup>
- Medication and forms due February 21st.
- On the day that your child leaves, bring:
  - Luggage
  - Sleeping bag & pillow
  - Lunch
  - Pencil/pen
  - Dressed ready to be outside
- Important Reminder:
   Be at RH between 9:00 9:30 am on
  - the departure day
     Be at RH by 1:00 pm on the day your child arrives home

- Forms in packet
- All medication should be in the Health Room by February 21<sup>st</sup>.
  - PLEASE PLEASE PLEASE, don't wait till the last minute!!
- Medication & forms must be turned in to the school's health room by an adult. Meds & forms must be turned in at the same time. Sample on how to fill out form provided. Must meet Dept of Health regulations very particular!
- One medication per form
  - Extra forms on the RH website
- All medication is returned at the end of Outdoor Education
- Prescriptions Medication?
  - Doctor MUST complete Part 2
- If we have a medication in the Health Room at RH - we will take it with us
  - You don't have to do anything
    - UNLESS there are additional dosages outside of the school day!
- Over the Counter Medication?
  - Parent completes Parts 1 & 2
    - No ranges (ie 4-6 hrs) Must be exact (ie every 6 hrs)
  - Medication MUST be in a new & unopened package

#### **OE Parent Volunteer Information**

All parent volunteers must send in the parent volunteer form found in the OE packet.

- All Parents Volunteers- at Rocky Hill or Camp Letts <u>MUST</u> complete the Child Abuse & Neglect training and submit proof no later than February 1<sup>st.</sup>
  - If have previously completed the training within the past 3 years, you do not need to take it again, please send Mrs. Quinn your confirmation # and feeder school where the training was completed.
  - 45 minutes 4 parts
  - Will receive a confirmation # at the end of the online training. SAVE THIS #!!
  - Within 24 hours your will receive a confirmation email. Forward this to Ms. Flynn or Mrs. Quinn

#### · CAMP LETTS VOLUNTEERS:

- Parents must be finger printed by February 1st. See website or packet for specific details. MCPS will conduct a criminal background check
  - MCPS employees & law enforcement exempt must submit proof of employment
  - Fingerprinting:
    - AIS (American Identity Solutions) \$20 w/voucher (found on RH website
    - AIS is here tonight to complete the fingerprinting process ©
    - Good for 3 years in any MCPS school!

### OE Informational Packet Meals

- Peanut & nut free site
- Basic food
  - Eggs, French Toast, sausage, turkey bacon, pancakes, fruit, cereal, yogurt, salad, hot dogs, pasta, taco bar, baked chicken, steamed veggies, cookies, brownies etc.
- Buffet Style
- All students will have KP (Kitchen Patrol) Duty. They will have to set, serve, and clean for at least one meal.
- Any dietary issues and/or restrictions? Lactose Intolerant? Vegetarian? Food allergies?

#### Academics

- 4 academic classes; 2 3 hrs each
  - Confidence Course
  - Watershed
  - Predator Prey
  - Treasure Earth
- Journal Writing
  - Students will have to record their daily events in a camp journal.
     Journals are collected, graded and then returned to students.
- Academic Program
  - This is an academic trip; not summer camp! Students will be assessed in each of their 5 academic classes on what they learned while at OE. We will spend lots of time preparing students for this trip & a lot of time afterwards in applying all the things we learned while there.
- Evening Activities the fun stuff!!
  - 1st night campfire, night hike & carnival
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> night Cabin Idol, Glow in the Dark Whiffle Ball, Hungry Hippos & Trust Walk.
