







Once inside a class...

The Course Menu

helps you go to different sections of a course.

Each course may look different depending on what your teacher has chosen to show and use.

The most commonly used menu items are Announcements and Assignments.

How do I Find The Calendar?

To access your calendar you will click on the “**Calendar**” icon on the **Blue Navigation bar**.

The calendar section of myMCPS Classroom will show you assignments and events your teachers have posted.

At Rosa Parks your homework assignments will be posted daily in the **calendar section** of MyMCPS Classroom.

How do I Find Announcements?

You can access announcements three different ways.

From the dashboard you can click on the **bullhorn icon** to view course announcements.



How do I Find Announcements?

The second way is while you are inside the course.

You will click on the “**Announcements**” option on your course navigation and you will see a list of all the announcements made in your course

The final way is that an **email notification** will appear in your MCPS Gmail (mcpsmd.net) account.



If you are in myMCPS Classroom you can access your grades by clicking on the resources option, then myMCPS Portal [Grades & Attendance].


Once you click you will be taken to the Student Portal and prompted to log in using your student ID and computer login password.
