



John Holland developed the RIASEC themes to help identify effective worker-fit.

RIASEC can describe personal interests and preferences. For jobs and tasks, the RIASEC can describe the style of work that is needed.

Students identifying and claiming their RIASEC themes can allow them to be aware of how they can excel.

Often, people who lead with Realistic like:

- hands-on activities
- making things
- being outdoors
- physical activity

REALISTIC

BUILD ACHIEVE REPAIR

Realistic value practicality and connecting their learning to real-world experiences.

These tend to be Kinesthetic learners

- Physical Flash Cards
- Handwritten Notes
- Incorporating movement
- Practical exercises like hands-on projects
- Games
- Reading notes out loud



Often, people who lead with Investigative like:

- Science
- reading & research
- challenging problems
- working independently

INVESTIGATIVE

QUESTION INVESTIGATE OBSERVE

Investigative students gravitate towards problem-solving, independent studies, and gaining new knowledge.

- Providing problems to solve or prompted questions
- Providing data to analyze
- Games and puzzles
- Encouraging in-depth research
 - Providing supplemental practices,
 knowledge, ideas to support their learning



Often, people who lead with Artistic like:

- creating things/crafting
- flexibility over rigidity
- strong aesthetics
- traveling

ARTISTIC

DEVELOP SELF-EXPRESS DESIGN

Artistic students tend to need room for selfexpression. They want to make sense and meaning of the content on their own.

Method

- Practices and projects with room for selfexpression
 - Writing prompts and self-reflections
 - Making graphics or illustrations
- Presenting through creative story telling
- Individualizing notes and flashcards
- Implementing sensory or unique experiences
- Providing a dedicated study space that will encourage studying



Often, people who lead with Social like:

- supporting others
- giving people advice
- volunteerism
- solving problems
 through discussion

SOCIAL

ASSIST SUPPORT SERVE

Social students are motivated by contact and exchange.

- Hosting conversations and discussions
- Asking Questions
- Learning in groups or through collaboration
- Teach-back
- Service Learning (Apply the information to how it impacts the community)
- Interactive games and quizzes



Often, people who lead with Enterprising like:

- leadership roles
- debate/politics
- public speaking
- taking risks

ENTERPRISING

INFLUENCE NEGOTIATE MOTIVATE

Enterprising students tend to learn through experiences and taking action

- Having the student present the information
- Making and defending arguments
- Friendly competition or challenges
- Setting goals to work towards



Often, people who lead with Conventional like:

- predictability
- working with numbers
- efficient processes
- games with clear rules and objectives

CONVENTIONAL

PLAN COORDINATE STRUCTURE

Conventional students value systems, order, clear objectives

- Having a routine and plan
- Making a checklist of items needed to be studied
- Practice tests
- Categorizing information to memorize/learn systematically
- Ensuring feedback is provided
- Providing a quiet and tidy study space
