Measures of Academic Progress Testing

MAP testing for our middle school students will take place on Tuesday (Reading) and Wednesday (Math), September 16th and 17th. The MAP assessment measures your child's academic growth throughout the school year and helps us tailor instruction to their needs. We encourage students to be well rested and eat a healthy breakfast on testing days. No extensive preparation is needed, the MAP reflects what students are already learning in class. Students will receive their results immediately upon completing the test. Students who are absent will make up the test.

Student Expectations Modules

This week, students will complete the Student Expectations Modules in their homeroom class. The modules outline MCPS student expectations. Students may enter the building at 7:50 AM, classes begin exactly at 8:15 AM. We have a parking lot and traffic/bus pattern. Please follow the signs and staff members that are directing traffic to keep everyone safe. Please find the bus schedules listed in the information grid below.

Cell phones

Odessa Shannon has an *Away All Day* electronics policy. We comply with the county expectations for cell phone usage in middle schools. We encourage students *not to bring* cell phones and other electronic devices, such as earbuds, to school. If students must bring their phones to school we ask them to keep them out of sight for the school day. Students are not allowed to use cell phones in the classroom, hallways or at lunch. They may only use them before and after school. The school is not responsible for lost or stolen cell phones/electronics. **If a device becomes a distraction parents will be notified and asked to pick up the cell phones.** This information will be shared multiple times with students on the first day of school and throughout the week. **If a student has to call home they may ask their teacher for a pass to make the call in the main office.**
