If a device becomes a distraction, parents/guardians will be notified and asked to pick up the item from the school.

Student Transition Day August 25, 2025	On Monday, August 25, 2025, MCPS will hold the first Student Transition Day. It will be a non-instructional, full day for students entering Grades K, 6, and 9, as well as students who are new to a school or to MCPS. Students will be picked up from their assigned bus stops at their regular school times. Students will ride their assigned bus home. We encourage all students new to Odessa Shannon Middle School to attend this orientation so they can meet their

	teachers, learn the layout of the school building, and get a head start on the school year.
First Day of School August 26, 2025	The first official day of school is on Tuesday, August 26, 2025.
OSMS Back to School Night September 10, 2025	OSMS will have our Back To School Night on Wednesday, September 10, 2025 from 6:30-8 PM. This is the opportunity to meet the teachers, counselors, and get any necessary information you may need for your child's academic success.
Bell Times and School Attendance	Regular school attendance is required. Students are expected to report to school on time and be prepared each day. The school day is from 8:10am-3:00 p.m. If students are not able to attend classes please email Ms. Yohana Martinez, attendance secretary at Johana S MartinezMartinez@mcpsmd.org or call the main office at (240) 740-4150. Students should bring in a note the next day about their excused absence in order to adjust the absence. Students are not supervised in the building until 7:50 a.m., therefore students should not be dropped off before this time as it is a safety concern. Students will remain outside until 7:50 AM We will have a new Student drop off area that is marked, please drop off students in the designated area only. Finally, to ensure that students receive the maximum instructional time, students will not be called out of class for messages and parents should avoid conflicts that interfere with class attendance as much as possible.
Cafeteria (Breakfast and Lunch) Information	OSMS is one of the schools that participate in the Community Eligibility Program (CEP) which means that every enrolled OSMS student will receive free breakfast and lunch. This does not include any a la carte items. Those will still be charged at their regular rate. If you have other students in your household and do not attend one of the chosen schools you will need to fill out the free and reduced lunch application as this information is used to determine eligibility for a variety of state/federal assistance programs. Applications will need to be completed online at the following website: www.MySchoolApps.com Students are not allowed to have food delivered to school. If you wish to drop off lunch for your child. It must be dropped off at the front office.

myMCPS Classroom/Canvas	The myMCPS-Canvas platform will continue to be used for teaching and learning during the school year. Students will access their assignments, receive messages and use this platform to turn in work as appropriate. *Parents/Guardians can access myMCPS Classroom via ParentVUE
Immunizations	All students' immunization records must be updated. Please make sure your child's records are up to date and completed. Proper documentation of required immunizations must be received before you can enroll your child in school. Please follow up with the school nurse via email Mariam_SamelareSawadogo@mcpsmd.orgn if you have any questions about immunizations.

Chrome books	Odessa Shannon will have Chromebook Carts with class sets of chromebooks available for student use in the classroom. For students who need a device to use at home, students, parents, and MCPS staff can fill out the <u>Student Home Use Chromebook Request</u> form on behalf of the student. The student's information will be verified for take-home device eligibility, and then a Chromebook will be sent to the school to be checked out to the student. Students will not be required to transport home-use Chromebooks to and from school.
Cell Phone/Electronics Policy	OSMS follows the county's expectations for cell phone non-use during the school day. Students are allowed to have cell phones at OSMS, however, it is highly encouraged they stay at home. If a student brings a cell phone/electronics of any kind to school to school, they must be turned off and out of sight during the instructional day, this includes lunch time and in the halls. We suggest and highly encourage students to keep phones/electronics at home or in their own locker during the school day. Please note that the school is NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT and a parent may have to pick up phones/electronics if they become an instructional distraction for the student.
Lockers	All students will be assigned a locker during the first week of school. Please note that backpacks and other bags need to fit within the locker space because students will not be allowed to carry bags to class. In many cases a luggage style bag with wheels and a pull handle will not fit, so please save your receipts in case a newly purchased bag needs to be returned.
