ADDENDUM to

Bylaws of the Silver Creek Middle School Parent Teacher Student Association

ARTICLE VI Officers and Their Election

Section 2. Officers and their election:

a. The officers of this local PTSA shall be a President, Executive President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Vice President- Diversity Council, Vice President-Communications, Vice President-Fundraising, Secretary, and Treasurer.

ARTICLE VII Duties of Officers Section

Section 8. Executive President

The Executive President shall:

- a. Work with the President to organize all meetings of the local PTSA, the board of directors, and the executive committee;
- b. assist in coordinating the work of the officers and committees of this local PTSA in order that the purposes may be promoted;
- c. be a member ex officio of all committees except the nominating committee;
- d. perform such other duties with the president as may be prescribed in these bylaws or assigned by the SCMS PTSA executive committee;
- e. represent this PTSA at all council meetings or send an alternate; and
- f. perform in their designated order the duties of the President in the absence or inability of that officer to serve.

Section 9. Second Vice President

The Second Vice President shall:

- a. act as aid to the President and Executive President;
- b. perform in the duties of the First Vice President in the absence or inability of that officer to serve;
- c. perform such other duties as may be prescribed in these bylaws or assigned by the SCMS PTSA executive committee; and
- d. be the executive president elect for the following school year.

Section 10. Vice President- Diversity Council

The Vice President, Diversity Council shall:

- a. organize activities to promote participation and inclusiveness in SCMS PTSA and school activities by all members of the parent and student body;
- b. provide outreach to all populations to ensure that language, race, special need, sexual orientation or identity, and/or cultural differences are not a barrier to SCMS PTSA participation or student success;
- c. solicit parent and student participation in the Diversity Council;
- d. report on Diversity Council activities at the general membership meetings of the SCMS PTSA;
- e. act as an aide to the President and Executive President;
- f. serve as a Chair of the Diversity Council; and
- g. perform such other duties as may be prescribed in these bylaws or assigned by the SCMS PTSA executive committee.

Section 11. Vice President- Communications

The Vice President, Communications shall:

- a. oversee the design, monitoring, updating, and use of social media sites for SCMS PTSA (Facebook, Twitter, SCMS list serve, and website) to advertise, promote, and inform the SCMS community of meetings, events, and other relevant information;
- b. coordinate all updates for SCMS PTSA announcements and events through the SCMS PTSA list serve, website, calendar, and social media sites;
- c. oversee the circulation of weekly or biweekly communication updates during the academic year on SCMS PTSA meetings, activities, events, and other relevant information for the school community; and
- d. perform such other duties as may be prescribed in these bylaws or assigned by the SCMS PTSA executive committee.

Section 12. Vice President- Fundraising

The Vice President, Fundraising shall:

- a. organize all fundraising efforts to achieve targeted budget goal to include, for example, direct donations, community events, and/or partnership fundraising;
- b. help recruit and provide leadership, coordination and assistance as needed to fundraising committee;
- c. communicate and coordinate with Treasurer and other members of the executive committee as necessary to set expectations for annual fundraising efforts and goals;
- d. coordinate with Treasurer as needed to track donations and to measure progress in reaching annual goal;
- e. work with other members of the executive committee to provide input and to set the following year's budget and fundraising goals; and
- f. perform such other duties as may be prescribed in the by-laws or assigned by the SCMS PTSA executive committee.
