

# GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING SUICIDAL CONTENT ON SOCIAL MEDIA


Disclaimer: Please take all threats of harm seriously and report immediate threats of harm to self or others to your local authorities by calling 911. Be sure to provide all the information you have when reporting suicidal content or behavior. Remember if you see something, say something. If you hear something, say something. If you're worried about something or someone, say something. Talking directly about suicide does not encourage or increase the possibility of suicide, in fact it often diffuses it. ### **Facebook**

1) If you feel like a friend's post indicates suicidal behavior, click on the arrow in the top right hand corner and click "Report."



2) There, you'll be given the option to contact the friend who made the post, contact another friend for support, or contact a suicide helpline.



- a. If you choose to call a suicide helpline, first you will hear a message telling you you've reached the helpline. Then a skilled, trained crisis will listen to you, understand your concerns, provide support, and share any resources that may be helpful.
- 3) After that, the post will then come to the attention of Facebook's global community operations team, a group of hundreds of people around the world who monitor flagged posts 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

If Facebook feels like the post indicates distress, it will contact the person who posted it. That person will be greeted with the following pop ups when he or she next logs in:


4) Then the reported user will see options to reach out to a friend or get tips and support:



5) If the reported user decides they'd like to talk to someone, they'll be prompted to call a friend, send a friend a Facebook message, or contact a suicide helpline. They can either call or message a suicide prevention expert. Facebook also provides videos that use true stories of people who have dealt with suicidal thoughts.

There's also a section that recommends simple relaxation techniques like baking, drawing, going for a walk or visiting a library.

Facebook will even help someone find a self-care expert.



## <u>Instagram</u>

If you know the person, you may consider sharing the contact information of a local helpline with them so they can get more information.

To report a post for self-harm or suicide:

- 1. Tap \*\*\* (iPhone and Windows Phone) or (Android) below the post
- 2. Tap Report Inappropriate
- 3. Select This photo puts people at risk > Self-harm

- 2) Click Report Self Harm and give description and contact information.




3) After Twitter assesses a report of self-harm or suicide, they will contact the reported user and let him or her know that someone who cares about them identified that they might be at risk. They will provide the reported user with available online and hotline resources and encourage them to seek help.

#### YouTube


 If you come across content in which someone is suicidal or engaging in self-harm, please contact local authorities and flag the video to bring it to YouTube's immediate attention. YouTube reaches out to these individuals with resources and works with suicide prevention agencies to provide assistance when possible.

  possible, including the URL of the Tumblr blog you are concerned about.
- While Tumble cares deeply about the members of the community, they do not have the

  an appropriate law enforcement official or other appropriate government resource as soon as



#### **Pinterest**

Pinterest doesn't allow anything on their site that promotes self-harm, eating disorders, or hard drug abuse. If you come across Pins or comments expressing life threatening suicidal thoughts or self-harm, please get in touch with your local authorities and report the content to Pinterest. Even if the content doesn't seem life threatening, still report it to Pinterest and they'll get in touch with the person who posted it. All reports are anonymous—Pinterest will never tell someone who reported their content.

#### To report a Pinner:

- 1) Go to the persons profile
- 2) Click the gear menu, then Report
- 3) Pick the reason for your report.
- 4) Confirm that you want to report



#### To Report a Pin.

- 1) Click the pin to see it close up
- 2) Click the flag button at the top of the pin
- 3) Pick the reason for your report and hit report pin
