

MCPS Success in the IB

- Almost 16,000 students enrolled in IB programmes in 2015–2016
- Over 3000 IB exams administered to MCPS students in 2015
- Students scored a 4 or better on 2369 exams
- Students scored a 5 or better on 1575 exams
- 315 Diplomas were earned in 2015
- MYP participation is positively related to greater success on AP and IB exams.
- Higher percentages of students who previously attended MYP schools achieved at least one college-ready score on AP or IB exams compared with students who attended non-MYP schools.
- Among students who took at least one IB exam, students who previously attended an MYP school took, on average, significantly more exams and they earned more scores of 4 or higher, compared with their non-MYP counterparts.
- More than 900 MCPS teachers are
 IB trained over 300 teachers this year alone!
- MCPS offers over 65 different diploma courses
- 25 MCPS educators are trained to conduct IB training, authorization visits, and verification visits.
- 15 MCPS educators are trained as IB Consultants



The IB in Montgomery County Public Schools

MCPS has expanded enrollment in IB from one school with 400 students in 1987 to over 16,000 students in 20 different schools with 24 programmes in 2015.

What's New with IB in MCPS?

- The IBCP is continuing to grow. Rockville HS will graduate its first group of IBCP this year and tripled enrollment in year 2 of implementation.
- Watkins Mill HS graduated their first cohort of 18 CP graduates in 2014, followed by 40 in 2015. Watkins Mill HS has 43 Senior CP students in line for the CP certificate.
- Watkins Mill Partnership (Montgomery Village MS, Neelsville MS, and Watkins Mill HS) are official IB Authorized Schools! Congratulations!
- Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. MS and Roberto W. Clemente MS are continuing their journey towards authorization.
- MCPS teamed with Prince Georges County to offer a multi-district teacher training IB workshops, providing networking opportunities for teachers. MCPS was able to offer this training to 125 teachers and administrators.
- The Diploma Programme (DP) MCPS added pilot course: IB Geography,
 IB Design Technology, IB World Religions, and IB Global Politics.
- College Gardens ES and Silver Spring International MS participated in the IB Evaluation visit and will use IB's feedback and the school's reflection to plan programme enhancements.

The Diploma Programme

The IB Diploma Programme (DP) is designed as an academically challenging and balanced programme of education with final examinations that prepares students, normally aged 16 to 19, for success at university and life beyond. The programme is normally taught over two years and has gained recognition and respect from the world's leading universities.

The Middle Years Programme

The IB Middle Years Programme (MYP), for students aged 11 to 16, provides a framework of academic challenge that encourages students to embrace and understand the connections between traditional subjects and the real world, and become critical and reflective thinkers.

The Primary Years Programme

The IB Primary Years Programme (PYP), for students aged 3 to 12, focuses on the development of the whole child as an inquirer, both in the classroom and in the world outside.

The IB Career-related Certificate

The IB Career-related Certificate (IBCC) is a new qualification that increases access to an IB education and is specifically designed to provide a flexible learning framework tailored by the school to meet the needs of students and the local community as well as the world beyond.
