Students sharpen their employability skills and gain experience in a non-school based business environment while under the guidance of a professional. Exposure to a career field can help students make a career choice and enhance their employability skills and network with professionals in their chosen field while earning high school credit.

- ***Positions can be paid or non-paid and integrate the work environment with professional classroom skills.**
- **75 hours of concurrent internship experience are required for each one-half internship credit.**
