- Students utilize a computer or iPad to take the test in groups – or as a class – wearing headsets.



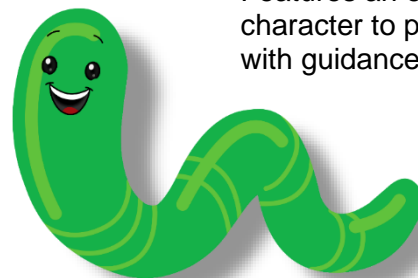
- Developmentally appropriate for young students
