High School Application Program Options for 2019-2020

Parent/Guardian of a Grade 10 Student High School Application Programs Report:

As you may know, all Montgomery County Public High Schools offer a wide variety of classes and rigorous programming designed to prepare students for the future challenges of college and the workplace. Current Grade 10 MCPS students may be eligible for application programs the following school year based on various eligibility criteria. We wanted you to be aware of other programming that may be of interest to your student, while you both explore the array of programming at your high school for next year. Please review the following information and review the programs for which your student may be eligible.

Below is important information to note as you consider your high school options:

1. Application programs are placed at schools based on school system needs and may be relocated to another site deemed by the Superintendent at any time.
2. MCPS bus transportation may be available and if available, varies for each program and is limited.
3. High school application program assignments occur on the conditions of stated eligibility requirements. Home address changes can impact assignment to a high school application program for the 2019-2020 school year.
4. If your child has special needs that can only be addressed through an Individual Education Plan (IEP), Best Interest Process, Alternative Placement or ESOL program, the school assignment through the high school application program process may be superseded.

The Visual Art Center (VAC) offers students a broad perspective of the fine arts and deepens their understanding of the opportunities for art-related careers through exposure to art history, contemporary artists and artwork.

Todas las escuelas secundarias de MCPS ofrecen una amplia variedad de clases y una programación rigurosa diseñada para preparar a su estudiante para los futuros desafíos de la universidad y el lugar de trabajo. Los estudiantes actuales de 10º grados de MCPS pueden ser elegibles para los programas de solicitud el siguiente año escolar según varios criterios de elegibilidad. Queríamos que estuvieran al tanto de otros programas que pueden ser de su interés a medida que explore la variedad de programación en su escuela secundaria para el próximo año. Revise la siguiente información y revise los programas para los que su estudiante es elegible:

A continuación, se incluye información importante para tener en cuenta al considerar las opciones que se ofrecen para la escuela secundaria:

1. Los programas de aplicación se colocan en las escuelas en base a las necesidades del sistema escolar y pueden ser reubicados a otro sitio, a juicio del Superintendente en cualquier momento.
2. El transporte en autobús de MCPS varía para cada programa. Revise los servicios de transporte en autobús en los sitios web específicos de cada programa.
3. Las asignaciones del programa de aplicación de la escuela secundaria ocurren en las condiciones de los requisitos de elegibilidad establecidos. La dirección del hogar y los cambios actuales en la escuela intermedia pueden afectar la asignación a un programa de solicitud de la escuela secundaria para el año escolar 2019-2020.
4. La asignatura de esta escuela puede ser inválida o anularse por una decisión hecha en la reunión de mejor colocación para su hijo/a. Esto aplica a estudiantes que están en programas de educación individualizada (IEP), estudiantes en programa de inglés para los que hablan otro idioma (ESOL), programas alternativos, y/ o otras reuniones para quienes deben esperar para una mejor colocación escolar.
