Parent Involvement in the School Improvement Plan Process

The *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001* (NCLB Act) includes specific requirements for increasing opportunities for families to be involved in their children's education. Parent involvement in the development and review of the School Improvement Plan (SIP) is a key component of the NCLB Act and is fully aligned with the Montgomery County Public Schools requirements and the implementation of the Baldrige guided school improvement process.

Schools in Montgomery County currently invite parents and community members to participate in the development and review of the SIP in many different formats. For example, some schools schedule time at a Parent – Teacher Association meeting to review the draft SIP.
