Summer RISE Overview

- Led by the Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) Partnerships Unit in collaboration with businesses, government agencies, educational institutions, and nonprofit organizations
- Opportunity for rising MCPS juniors and seniors
- Since 2017, 1,171 students have participated in Summer RISE

SUMMER RISE PURPOSE

Cultivates a talent pipeline for high-paying, high-demand jobs

Exposes companies to the enthusiasm, creativity, and innovative ideas of students

Provides an enriching career-based learning opportunity

Teaches students about the different departments in a company

Career Opportunity

Not an internship (based on FLSA)

Not shadowing

Not to replace an employment vacancy

It is about an experience where a student(s) learns about a career or several careers during the course of Summer RISE

INFORMATION & LOGISTICS

July 6 - 31, 2020

Flexible schedule | 3-4 weeks | 60-80 hours | 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

Summer RISE will be advertised to rising juniors and seniors and to students currently in career readiness programs

Validate that the student has completed a minimum of 60 hours

Hosts can express interest in students who speak different languages

TIPS FOR HOSTS

- Recommend hosting 2 students as a minimum
- Suggested 15-20 hours a week, no more than 8 hours a day
- Cannot engage in activities for more than 5 continuous hours without a 30-minute break
- Trial opportunity that can lead to an internship and/or apprenticeship and eligibility for a business tax credit

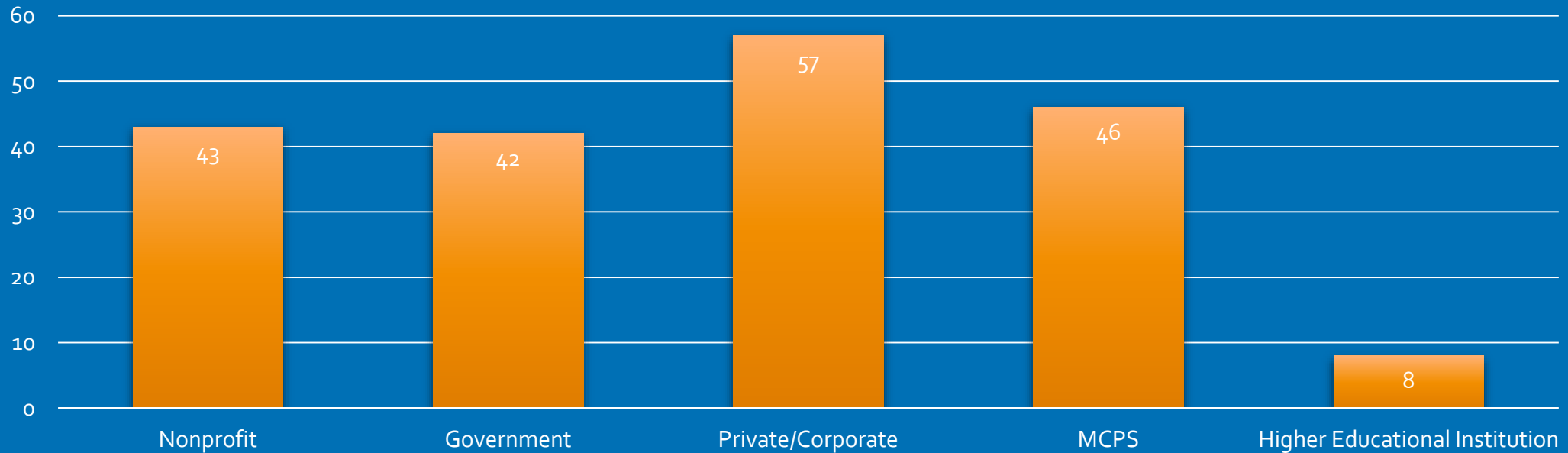




Summer RISE 2019 Hosts at a Glance

Of the 2019 Summer RISE hosts:

96%

responded that they would be willing to host students again next year

90%

rated the program very good (53%) to good (37%)

79%

stated they thought the students were well prepared (78%) or prepared (1%) for the Summer RISE experience

74%

felt the student(s) displayed potential for their talent pipeline
