

CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (CPD) EARNED FROM OUTSIDE AGENCIES FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) credit cannot be earned during school/work hours by professional staff unless personal or annual leave is requested. Professional staff cannot use professional leave to take a CPD course. A copy of your approved leave form must accompany your MSDE CPD Credit Form.

3. How do you verify that a course carries MSDE credit?

- Contact the outside agency or check the outside agency flyers and catalogs for credit information. All approved courses have a Maryland State Department of Education CPD number.

3. At the completion of the course, do you receive a grade?

- You will receive credit slip form titled “Maryland State Department of Education CPD Completion For Credit Form.”

4. How is the MSDE CPD Credit Form processed?

- Submit form to MCPS CPD Registrar, OHRD/DCS, 45 West Gude Drive, Suite 2300, Rockville, Maryland 20850.
- The form is signed, if applicable, by the Professional Development Liaison between MCPS and MSDE.
- The CPD office will distribute the original to the Certification Unit and copy to participant.

5. How are MSDE credits used?

- Renewal of the Maryland certificate
- Salary advancement

6. Do outside agencies charge tuition?

- Some agencies do charge tuition. However, you may be eligible for tuition reimbursement through the [MCPS teacher tuition reimbursement program](#). Contact the tuition reimbursement office directly with questions about reimbursement.
