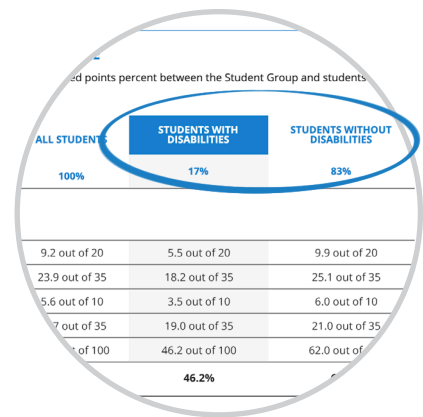
For elementary and middle schools, the Academic Progress indicator now includes student performance on state science tests.
