

Seneca Valley Pony Club is hosting our horse trials on Saturday, June 17 and Sunday, June 18 (Father's Day) at Bittersweet Field in Poolesville, Maryland. **Students can get up to 8 SSL hours per day at the horse trials.** We also have horse trials on September 2-3 as well. Horse trials involve three different phases of riding: dressage, stadium jumping and cross country jumping.

We have jobs for students with no horse experience such as parking (helping direct horse trailers and cars entering the site), running scores (bringing score sheets from judges to the scoring team), jump crew (assisting replacing poles that horses knock down) and gate attendants (helping to open and close gates for horses and riders). For students with experience with horses, we have dressage warm up, stadium gate keepers and cross country jump judge positions available.

The SVPC horse trials attract hundreds of professional and amateur riders. Our volunteers receive a T-shirt, lunch and a schooling pass (good for one of SVPC's open schooling days).
