

DuFief Elementary School Computer Policy

Appropriate Conduct and Use

1. All use of computer equipment, networks, and other technology resources must be for educational purposes as defined above.
2. Although it is impossible to document all appropriate conduct and use of the computers, the following guidelines provide examples of computer and network use infractions that are prohibited:
 - a. System tampering (and unauthorized alteration of operating systems, individual accounts, software, networking facilities, and/or other programs) and/or equipment damage.
 - b. Decrypting passwords and/or gaining unauthorized higher level access or privileges or attempting to do so
 - c. Interfering with other users
 - d. Using language, pictures, or other materials that is obscene, vulgar, or abusive
 - e. Permitting others to use one's account or password
 - f. Copying or transferring copyrighted materials and software without authorization
 - g. Posting personally identifiable information about yourself, other students, or staff without authorization
3. Although access to the Internet is unobstructed for students, accessing the Internet without the permission and/or knowledge of the teacher is prohibited.
4. An adult must monitor all use of the computer by students.
