

Gaithersburg High School H1N1 Emergency Plan

Health and school officials have instructed each school to develop a H1N1 Emergency Plan in case the H1N1 flu virus affects normal school operations. Please read the important highlights below for students and parents.

Gaithersburg High School will provide continuing instruction during emergencies and school closure. Lessons and assignments will be posted on Edline. It is important that all parents and students activate their Edline accounts. Please call the school if you have questions about activating your account. Students are responsible for obtaining the assignments from Edline, completing the work, and returning the assignments via email. Students may use the computers in public libraries if they do not have computer access at home. In addition, hard copies will be available at a specified location at school if students do not have computer access. Teachers will provide feedback on assignments that are submitted by students.

In case of an emergency, all GHS families will be notified via Connect-Ed, Edline, PTSA List-serve, and the GHS website. Information will be provided regarding instruction and school operations. It is important that all families update their contact information for communication via Connect-Ed. In addition, please visit the GHS website often and join the PTSA List-serve.

Lastly, we will regularly discuss and post protocols for good hygiene, such as hand-washing and sneezing and coughing into the elbow with students. Please reinforce these practices at home.
