On Tuesday, February 12, 2019 from 9:40 am to 10:25 am all female students in the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade will be invited to participate in *Check It Out*<sup>TM</sup> for Teens, an assembly program focused on breast cancer awareness. Breast cancer is the second most common form of cancer in women. The goal of *Check it Out*<sup>TM</sup> is to empower young women to take responsibility of their own breast health.

Professional staff from Suburban Hospital as well as a breast cancer survivor will provide information about breast cancer, stressing the value of developing good health habits, including monthly breast self-awareness checks, and the importance of early detection of the disease. Students are encouraged to ask questions and to share information from the program with the adult women in their lives.

Mothers of all female students in grades 11 and 12 are invited to attend this 45-minute assembly with their daughters.
