- ❑ Account creation requires an email address*
- ❑ Parents/Guardians have received a letter to the student's primary address containing the **Access ID** and **Access Password** needed to connect their account to their student
- ❑ If the letter was not received, please contact the school office to have a new letter printed.

Navigation

- Grades → Toggle between multiple students
- Grade History → Report card grades from current and previous years and interims
- Attendance → Daily attendance report
- Consent Forms
- myMCPS Classroom → Link to myMCPS Classroom
- My Schedule → Student's courses/subjects/teachers
- Class Registration
- Google Classroom (Student) → Link to Google Classroom (parents must login using child's Google Apps email & password)
- School Information → School contact information
- Document Library → Access to MAP testing reports
- Curriculum Resources → Access English/Math curriculum resources for parents
- Account Preferences → Change password, add students, manage notifications
