

# The Parent Role During Online Lessons

Thank you for your support as we embrace this new way of learning - Online Learning! Since the time designated for your child's grade level is limited, we have come up with some ways you can help your child maximize his/her online learning experience.

## Do's

- ✓ Help your child log in up to 10 minutes early to ensure that she/he is able to log in. The teacher will not be able to assist you with login issues during the lesson.
- ✓ Make sure your child is seated in a quiet area, with minimal to no distractions. Toys, tablets, or other devices should not be nearby or available.
- ✓ Parents may choose to be near the student to keep them on-task or help them with technology, but please remain off-camera.
- ✓ If you have an issue logging in, know that the teacher will not be able to use class time to help troubleshoot a technical issue. **Please email your issue to the teacher or tech support\***
- ✓ Please do your best to keep siblings and pets off-camera.
- ✓ Send a message through email/ClassDojo to your child's teacher with any questions about times, assignments, or other school topics.
- ✓ Make sure students are dressed for learning (i.e., no bathrobes or revealing clothing items). The students should wear clothes that they would have chosen to wear to attend the school.
- ✓ **Support your child(ren) as they complete the required lessons between each Zoom session.**
  - Before the sessions on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, they should have watched and completed their Eureka Lesson.
  - Before Tuesday and Thursday sessions, they should have read and completed their Benchmark Literacy work.

## Don'ts

- ⊘ Do not talk to the teacher, the class or ask any questions. *Class time is reserved only for student and teacher interactions.*
- ⊘ Do not appear on camera so as not to distract other students.
