# FAQ



Q: How old do I need to be to sign up for Driver's Ed?

A: You'll need to be at least 15 years old.

Q: Do I need a permit to sign up?

A: You don't, but whenever you get behind the wheel with anyone, including our awesome instructors, you'll need one.

Q: How long are classes?

A: Classes are two weeks long, Monday through Friday, three hours each day. You get 15 minute break about an hour and a half into class.

Your drives with an instructor will be two hours long and you'll get three of them. So, as required by the MVA, 30 hours of classroom time and 6 hours of driving.

Q: How do I sign up?

A: Online or by phone! (Payments are not required in order to sign up!)

Q: How much are classes and what's included?

A: \$350. Your driver's education requirements are included: 30 hours of classroom time and six hours of driving.

Q: What do I need to bring to class?

A: We'll ask for a government issued ID. (birth certificate, passport or if you have it already, your learner's permit!) You may also bring something to write with. Don't worry about bringing a notebook. When you get to class, you'll get a student workbook that has a section for you to jot down notes.

If you haven't paid your tuition, make sure you bring your payment too!

Q: Am I going to be driving within the two weeks?

A: You can. As long as you've paid your tuition in full, you're more than welcome to schedule your drives as long as it does not interfere with class. We recommend holding off until you have a bit of experience though.
