RMHS students will read poetry or spoken word by Hispanic poets.

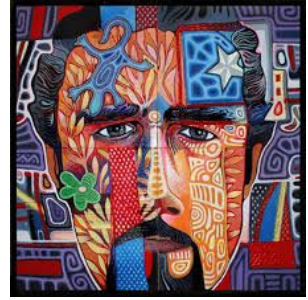
RMHS Hispanic student poets may also read their own poetry.
