

## 2019-2020 Tilden Middle School Registration Form & Guide to Online Registration - *Grade 6*

*Use this form to guide you through the online registration process. This form and the printed online registration confirmation need to be turned into your 5<sup>th</sup> grade homeroom teacher by **February 14<sup>th</sup>**. Use the provided Tilden Grade 6 Supplement for more information about the various courses available to you. Sign into the registration system and follow this guide as you proceed, section by section.*

Students are to use their usual MCPS login information (what they use to log on to a computer at school) to sign into the MyMCPS Student Portal. A link is available on Tilden's website ([portal.mcpsmd.org/public](http://portal.mcpsmd.org/public)). Once signed in, your name will show in the upper corner as well as the center of the screen. Click on "Class Registration" from the menu on the left of the screen to begin selecting classes.

**Required Core Courses:** All students are pre-registered for Science, World Studies and Health/Physical Education. This section is just for your information and you do not need to do anything within this section.

**English & ESOL Courses:** Click on the image of a pencil to the right of this section. Students will see the teacher recommended course if they are an ESOL student and should select that course by checking the box to the left and clicking "okay." If there is no ESOL recommendation, select Advanced English 6.

**Math Courses:** Click on the image of a pencil to the right of this section. Students will see the teacher recommended course and should select that course by checking the box to the left and clicking "okay."

**Grade 6 Reading Requirement:** Click on the image of a pencil to the right of this section. If you have a teacher recommendation, select that course. If you do not have a recommendation, do not select any of the courses.

**Digital Literacy or World Language:** If you were recommended for a reading class in the section above, skip this section. If you do not have a reading recommendation, you can choose to take Digital Literacy or select a world language in its place. If you would like to take both Digital Literacy and world language, select Digital Literacy in this section and world language in the elective section coming up.

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## Electives:

Please refer to the Tilden Grade 6 Supplement for detailed elective course descriptions. Online registration has 3 separate sections for choosing electives so we know which was your first, second and third choice. Please choose 1 elective per section. Theatre/FACS, Studio Art/Tech & Design and Imagineering/Tech & Design are paired semester electives. If you choose Theatre, FACS will be automatically added later. If you choose Studio Art, Tech & Design will be automatically added later. If you choose Imagineering, Tech & Design will be automatically added later. **Please make sure to click “SUBMIT” after selecting all your courses.** Your selections are not saved if you do not click “SUBMIT.” Please print the course confirmation which displays after you submit your choices.

Please duplicate your online elective choices below using numbers 1 through 3 with 1 being your first choice. If you choose a World Language and you have previous experience with that language which may place you in a level higher than 1A, please check the “prior experience” box to the right of your chosen language.
