ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL SAFETY

Arrival and dismissal are busy times and we want all students to remain safe. **Although staff are on duty to assist with monitoring students, MCPD does not want staff directing street traffic for safety and liability reasons.** It is your civic duty and responsibility as a parent/guardian to adhere to procedures. The WLES traffic flow map is attached to this newsletter.

- Do **NOT** drive around other cars.
- Have students exit the cars on the right side closest to the sidewalk
- Drop students off on school grounds in the car circle
- Do **NOT** drop students off on Waters Landing Drive
- **DO NOT PARK ON WATERS LANDING DRIVE AND WALK ACROSS THE BUS LOOP TO PICK UP STUDENTS**
- **Do NOT make a left hand turn from Locbury Drive**
- **Do NOT form a double line to enter the car loop**
