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MESSAGE FROM MS. GODDARD, PRINCIPAL

Happy March! As spring approaches, we begin planning for the excitement of graduation and the end of the school year. Please note that interim grades are being published around March 8th, as the 3rd marking period ends on **April 3**. Finish strong!

The **countdown to graduation** has begun—with only about three months left until our commencement ceremony on, **Friday, June 7 at 2:30 p.m.!** In the meantime, please visit the **Senior Page** for additional details about senior events and graduation. College **acceptances** and other **scholarships** are coming in at a rapid pace for the Class of 2019! Millions of dollars in merit-based scholarships have already been reported to our Career Center. **If you receive notice** of any merit-based awards or scholarships—whether you intend to go to that college or not—please report it to Mrs. Heald in the Career Center. We want to hear about all scholarships that are offered to any school to which you applied. We would like to tally all of the scholarship offers and have an accurate count. Keep those award letters coming in!

Looking ahead to the 2019-20 school year, counselors are in the process of finalizing course selections for students for next year. At this point, all students should have registered for their courses through the online scheduler portal, with selections about IB, AP, and Honors courses, electives, and special programs for next school year. Parents will be sent verifications of course selections in early May. In the meantime, if you have a question about your child's course selections, please contact your child's counselor.

Please note that staffing decisions and final course offerings are based on these student selections, and we are now in the process of drafting the master schedule for next year. We will be offering a full array of advanced courses in the IB Diploma, IB Career-related Program, career academies, AP courses, support classes, and elective choices. If you have any questions about course selections or placement, please feel free to call or e-mail appropriate staff. However, *please note that courses without sufficient enrollment will risk being eliminated.*

As we finish this marking period, I would like to emphasize the myriad of ways that students can get **extra help**, with multiple opportunities being offered after school, and at STEP. Please encourage your child to seek that extra help, as the staff and I are here to ensure student success any way we can.

The 3rd marking period ends on **April 3rd** and report cards will be issued (sent home via your student) on **April 16th**. The last marking period will begin on Thursday, **April 4**.

SPORTING NEWS

We are excited to announce that the Athletics Registration application for Spring Sports through the [myMCPS](#) Parent Portal is open. This will include all registration for spring interscholastic athletic teams and corollary athletic teams. The myMCPS Parent Portal is a secure registration platform that provides you with an easy, user-friendly way to register for our athletic programs. It will help us to be more administratively efficient, environmentally responsible, and provide an electronic registration service convenient for our families. Information that you have already entered into the Emergency Card for your student or any previous interscholastic athletic registration will also prepopulate, saving you time from season to season. It is highly recommended that athletics online registration be completed no later than 48 hours prior to the March 1, 2019, Spring Sports tryout date. In addition, only one submission should be completed for each student-athlete. For student safety and security, in the event of a custody issue, instead of using the online Athletics Registration application, parents or guardians must either download the required forms from the Forms page on the Montgomery County Public Schools Athletics website or contact the student's school to receive a paper copy of

the forms. A completed hard copy of the forms must be submitted to the school before the student can participate in tryouts or practices.

Registration Information: The following information will be required to submit an athletics registration:

- Contact information for the student’s parents or guardians and emergency contacts
- Doctor and dentist name and phone number
- Health insurance information (company name and type of insurance) and hospital preference
- Pre-participation Physical Evaluation for Athletics (Form SR-8) The Pre-participation Physical Evaluation Form is valid for one year from the date of the exam and covers participation for all sports within that time period. If a student participated in a previous high school sport the date on file will pre-populate when registering. The physical exam signature page is the only page needed for a student-athlete to participate. This page can either be uploaded directly into the system for the Athletic Director to review or a hard copy of the page can be submitted to the Athletic Director for entry.
- Tetanus Shot Date
- Allergy and Medication Information
- Health Conditions and Treatment Information
- Traumatic Brain Injury Information (including dates of injuries and results)

Registration Application Process: After logging in, to the myMCPS Parent Portal, click on the **Spring Sports Season** Athletic Registration tab located at the bottom of the left side menu.

1. The main navigation path is located on the left side of the page and indicates the current step of the registration process. Following initial login to the portal, you will land on the introduction page. Use the **Next** button to advance one page, or the **Previous** button to go back one page while navigating the portal.
2. Review the information that you entered on the Athletic Registration application. After you have reviewed the forms and made any necessary changes, click the Submit button. After selecting 'Submit', the registration will be complete and you will be able to save/download or print a copy of your registration for your own reference, and you will receive an e-mail confirming your completed submission.

STUDENT PARKING PERMIT, 2nd SEMESTER 2018

Student parking permits for 2nd semester are on sale now for **\$37.50**. The permit applications are available in the Financial Office. Students must complete an application that has been signed by a parent. Only permitted cars are allowed on our campus.

Parking on the school campus is a privilege. Student parking permits are sold each semester in order to provide supervised student parking for all student drivers *and* safety on the school campus.

All parking permits must be displayed appropriately from the rear view mirror. The school security staff will ticket cars without permits. Cars receiving 3 warning tickets will be towed. Parking permits may be revoked for violations such as speeding or unsafe behaviors involving the vehicle, or other infractions of school rules.

Temporary or daily permits will be available for \$1.00 per day from the Financial Office. These permits will be offered for students who may have occasional driving needs. Students with daily permits will have a special permit and must sign in each day.
