

## **Tutoring Opportunities at WJ – from Counseling Services**

Counselors recommend students always first seek help from their own teachers. Teachers already personally know them and recognize their individual learning needs. Teachers have the advantage of knowing what coursework is being taught and what assignments are pending. Most teachers are available in their classrooms at lunch, and often before or after school. Teachers ask that students show courtesy by making an “informal” appointment so there are no hard feelings if a teacher is not available because of another commitment.

In cases where it is not working out for students to get help from their own teacher, a number of tutoring options are available at WJ.

**Math Honor Society:** math tutoring will be held in **Room 245** on **Mondays** and **Wednesdays** at **lunch**.

**ESOL Honors Society** offers peer tutoring in most subjects at **lunch** on **Thursdays** in **Room 122**.

**Family & Consumer Sciences (FACS) Department** teachers are available to students on an individual basis at **lunch** or **after school, as needed**. Students should talk to or email their teachers to arrange sessions.

**Chinese Honor Society:** tutoring is offered every **Wednesday** during **lunch** in **Room G32**. No appointment is necessary.

**French Honor Society:** tutoring is offered every **Wednesday** at **lunch** in **Room G09 (Oct. - Jan.)**.

**Italian Honor Society** offers tutoring every **Tuesday** and **Thursday** in **Room G33** at **Lunch**. No appointment is necessary.

**Latin Honor Society** offers tutoring every **Tuesday** in room **G10** at **lunch**. No appointment is necessary.

**Spanish Honor Society:** offers tutoring every **Tuesday** and **Thursday** in **Portable 6** at **lunch**. No appointment necessary.
