Sept. 3	First week of MC Fall classes held on campus or online (distance learning)
Sept. 4 - 5	Generally, MC classes held at WJ begin the Wed or Thurs after Labor Day. Students can confirm start date/time by logging into their MyMC accounts.

\*\* The AP Exam dates are set nationally and students must test during that time. In case of a schedule conflict, individual students must communicate with faculty at the start of the semester and work with them, in conjunction with MCPS DEPA, to determine appropriate make up plan for any missed class during the required testing time. Students may also be required to take a state HSA exam sometime in April

\*\*\* The Spring semester schedule can be extended one week for college courses offered at the high school and USG to account for significant missed time due to weather closings or AP exam scheduling. At the professors discretion and in coordination with the Dual Enrollment office.
