Dear Parents, Guardians, and Staff Members,


I am writing to share information about radon testing at your school. In 2016, all Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) were tested for radon. We also conduct periodic testing to ensure that radon levels in schools continue below the action level of 4.0 picocuries per liter of air (pCi/L), which is recommended by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). For schools that have an active radon mitigation system, periodic retesting occurs every two years. For facilities that showed no elevated radon levels, retesting is conducted every five years.

Attached is a summary of the retesting results that recently occurred at your school. The full test result report is posted to the MCPS Radon Testing and Mitigation Program web page at

The most recent test results indicate that all rooms and offices tested at your school had radon levels below the EPA recommended action level of 4.0 pCi/L. Periodic testing will continue on the schedule described above.
