



REMINDER

Maryland State law requires that the following student groups provide proof of one (1) tetanus, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis (Tdap) and one (1) meningococcal (MCV4) vaccination in order to start school on September 5, 2017:

- Students entering Grade 7
- Students newly enrolling in a Maryland school in Grades 8, 9, and 10
 - Students who are repeating Grade 10

You must provide proof of vaccination to your student's school by September 5, 2017.

The Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services is offering free vaccination clinics throughout July and August.
