

The Spanish Immersion Program follows the MCPS curriculum at all grade levels. In Kindergarten through third grade, Spanish immersion students receive instruction in all subject areas in Spanish. Fourth grade allows opportunities for Reading and Writing instruction in both languages. In 5th grade, students continue their Spanish Immersion program in Math, Science and Social Studies. All MCPS elementary school students are welcome to apply! Entry into the SI Program is by lottery. No Spanish skills are required when applying to grades K or 1.
