



College Application Fee Waiver Information Ways to Pay for Application Fees:

The Common App:

Log into your Common Application Account. You can find the Common App Fee Waiver in the Profile section of the Common App tab. To apply for this fee waiver:

- Answer “Yes” to the fee waiver statement.
- Select all the indicators in the list that apply to you.
- Enter your signature to certify your request

Make sure your counselor is aware that you have made the request so they can authorize that you are eligible for this application fee waiver through Naviance eDocs. You will still be able to submit your application without a fee while your counselor confirms.

The Coalition App:

We make it easy: In the Fee Waiver section of your MyCoalition Profile, simply check all applicable criteria boxes (such as “I have received a College Board fee waiver.”) and you’ll see a list of all the schools that will waive your application fees based on your qualification. We don’t require any additional documentation or verification. Eligibility criteria include: qualifying for the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program, receiving a College Board, ACT, and/or NACAC fee waiver; being eligible for a Pell Grant, participating in TRIO programs.

Through College Board with the use of an SAT Waiver

If you used a fee waiver to cover the cost of SAT registration, College Board offers up to 4 college application fee waivers. Access the forms through your College Board account. You will see them available after scores are released or if you are a junior, they will be available to you in the fall of your senior year. College application fee waiver facts are available @
