Each day we will celebrate Arab Americans throughout the past and present, and recognize their invaluable contributions to our country.

- **Farouk El-Baz:** Geologist Farouk El-Baz has conducted field investigations in every major desert on earth and searched for groundwater. He's credited with discovering groundwater resources in Egypt, Oman, Somalia, Sudan and the United Arab Emirates. Born in Egypt, El-Baz served as NASA's lead geologist for the Apollo space program from 1967 to 1972. Following that, he launched the Center for Earth and Planetary Studies at the National Air and Space Museum. Today, El-Baz is a professor and director of the Center for Remote Sensing at Boston University.
