What Do We Do?

- Empower parents, guardians and students by providing information about educational issues
- Host workshops and meetings to educate parents to be effective advocates for their children
- Promote parental involvement
- Design and implement programs that provide academic support to students
- Collaborate PTSA and MCPS developing strategies to close the achievement gap
- Outreach to parents and students
- Provide a forum for information exchange
- Refer and link students with programs that provide academic support and enrichment
- Teach school staff about the students they serve
- Attend PTSA meetings monthly and sit on executive committees
- Organize or participate in at least three programs each school year usually including Back to School Night to publicize the Parents' Council at your school, a Black History Month Program, and meet to discuss issues of concern and deliver information.

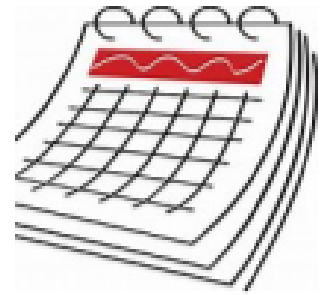
